

**Minutes of Cemetery Meeting held on

- 1. Apologies**  
There were no apologies
- 2. Matters Arising**

- 3. Proposed Expenditure**  
An estimate of £450 + VAT had been received for the pruning of the trees in Aldborough cemetery and removal of rubbish at the side of the Water Rats Club. It was proposed Cllr Fuller, seconded Cllr Winder and agreed that this estimate be accepted
- 4. Burial Board Meetings**  
It was proposed Cllr Cooper, seconded Cllr Winder and agreed that future Burial Board meetings would be held at 6.00 p.m. prior to the Town Council Meetings held on the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of each month. The burial clerk to speak to the Town Clerk with regard to Agendas, Minutes, estimates etc. as to who was going to do what.
- 5. Moles in Aldborough Cemetery**  
There was still an on-going problem with moles. Discussion took place as to who may be able to help. The burial clerk to try and find someone to deal with the problem.
- 6. Transfer- of Exclusive Rights of Burial**  
The burial' clerk had been to the Bereavement Services offices at Stonefall to seek advice and guidance regarding the transfer of Exclusive Rights of Burial. Mr Pillar from the Bereavement Services had offered to come and speak to the council members regarding this. It was agreed Mr Pillar be invited to attend the next Town Council meeting.
- 7. Garden of Remembrance**  
Cllr Cooper had met with Nick Spence. It was thought that the original proposed site for the Garden of Remembrance was unsuitable as it was under trees and near the hedge. It was felt that a more suitable area of the cemetery be found and the clerk was asked to check the plans as to availability of space.
