6.64.11.D.FUL Erection of two storey rear and single storey side extensions. Aldene, Back Lane, Aldborough – The Town Council has no objections

6.64.145.J.TPO Felling of 1 Larch Tree, tree T1 of Tree Preservation Order 06/2004. 36 The Chase, Boroughbridge – The Town Council objects on planning grounds

6.64.671.FUL Erection of single storey rear extension. 23 Kingfisher Reach, Boroughbridge – The Town Council has no objections
