



Sure Start is the government programme to deliver the best start in life for every child. It brings together early education, childcare, health and family support. Children's centres provide a variety of advice and support for parents and carers. Their services are available to you from pregnancy right through to when your child goes into reception class at primary school.

Boroughbridge Children's Centre is based at Boroughbridge Primary School on York Road. It brings together all the different support agencies to offer a wide range of services to meet you and your child's needs, all in one place. As well as running services from the Children's Centre, we aim to run activities in the surrounding villages. It's somewhere your child can make friends and learn as they play. You can get professional advice on health and family matters, learn about training and job opportunities or just socialise with other people.

Tuesday - A **toy library** session for parents with babies and young children up to 5 years of age; an opportunity to borrow from our selection of toys and to meet with other local parents. 1.30-3.00pm. **Midwife**, Morag White, will also be around to provide information or advice to expectant and new parents.

Thursday - A **Stay and Play** group, newly formed by local parents and looking for more to join! Come along with your little ones to chat, play and share ideas. A **health visitor** will be popping in on a monthly basis to talk about common challenges faced by parents! 10-11.30am.
