

Home delivery companies Amazon, DHL, Evri, Royal Mail and UPS are the top five brands impersonated by scammers targeting the UK, and with Christmas fast approaching, we are warning shoppers to expect a flurry of fake texts and emails.

These messages invite you to click links to copycat delivery websites so that scammers can steal your payment details or even retarget you with perfectly timed bank impersonation scams.

Never click on a link received via a text about a delivery, this could be a scam.

Stop and think, you shouldn't have to pay a fee for a missed delivery. If you're unsure and you think you have a package arriving, remain vigilant and check delivery notifications very carefully to ensure they are genuine.

Check what you've ordered online and track your parcel through the websites of legitimate delivery companies.
