



Reporting speeding

Hello all

There has been reports of speeding in and around Boroughbridge town.

There is a process in place in order to determine the most appropriate action to be taken in regards to speeding issues based on data collected.

This process is the Speed Management Protocol and is essentially a way for members of the public to submit complaints about a road they are concerned about, which we will then collect data from and implement the best outcome from the speed data. Roads with a relatively high speeding problem will be referred to the Safety Camera Team for enforcement or to Highways to put in an engineering solution (speed bumps / chicanes etc). Roads with a relatively low or no speeding problem will be referred to the Community Speed Watch scheme.
